Guangzhou

- By plane:** Guangzhou Baiyun International Airport
- By coach from Hong Kong:** Takes 3.5 hours from Hong Kong International Airport (Terminal 2) to Guangzhou. Service runs daily 07:00 – 23:00
- By train from Hong Kong:** Hunghom Station to Guangzhou East Railway Station. Travel time: Approx. 1 hour and 40 minutes. Oneway ticket fare: HK\$190 (First class) & HK\$230 (Premium class)

❑ **Arriving by Metro:** Fares range from RMB 2 to 12. To visit **Area A** of the venue (Hall 1-8), get off at Xin Gang Dong Station (Exit A); to visit **Area B** (Hall 9 -13), get off at Pazhou Station (Exit A)

❑ **Arriving by Taxi:** The most convenient way to get to the venue. The fee is approximately RMB 40 for a single trip from Guangzhou East Railway Station and takes around 25 minutes.

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Special tips

❑ **Currency** used in China is Renminbi “RMB”. The coins in circulation are one Yuan, five jian and one jiao. Banknotes range from one Yuan to 100 Yuan. You are suggested to exchange RMB before leaving the airport.

❑ **Time** in China is GMT +8 all year around.

❑ **Electrical current** is 220V / 50Hz AC. Make sure to bring an adaptor with you for charging your electronic device.
